News Section is ID:1 and Sports ID:23 and I set those already, but content items only show if I set them to never expire. I need to solve this. Thank you...

Only making test, setting different categories, some articles showed up, and when I looked at their parameters, the only difference was that they were set to NEVER expire.

If I create a content item, a news article, and set it to expire, then the module wont display it. If I change that setting, to NEVER expire, the the article shows.

That works, but you can imagine the extra work I would have to go trough, just to manually unpublish articles. It should not work this way.

I have checked all parameters and and find nothing wrong. Whan can be causing this problem??

Also, since I installed the module, my date displayed change to english, even having Spanish set as default language, and country locale setting to es\_ES@euro. How con I fix this other problem?
