Now, I have 2 questions:

1. How can I change the date language? My site is in French so I would like to show the date in French, not in English. I can't find where to translate the months, etc.
2. My articles' pictures are not in images/stories, they are in images/"different directories depending on the category of the article". So, how can I get my articles' pictures to show instead of the default image? If I move the image in the image/stories directory it works, but I don't want to do this as I don't want to have 3000 pictures all mixed up together in one single directory.

I guess that I need to change this line in order to have the module pull the images outside of the images/stories directory:
`$image_path = $params->get('image_path', 'images/stories');`

but what do I write if I want the module to pick up the images in many different directories inside the images directory. eg.
images/news
images/kids
images/adults
images/and so on

And as for the date language I have no clue what I have to change where.
